### ENGLAND TO ENTER CLASSIC III

Richard Busby of Century City Ltd. in London, England has been in touch with the NPCA to arrange a spot for several of England's pro pool players to compete in the 1983 NPCA Classic. Century City Ltd. is the tournament and T.V. promotion company for the United Kingdom's Professional Pool Players Organization.

### 3 CUSHIONS BIGGEST AND BEST IN CHICAGO

\$15,500.00 was distributed to the winners of the largest American 3-cushion billiard tournament in over 30 years. It has been said that this country has not seen an event of this type with this many good players since the World Championship at Navy Pier in 1952. The event was sponsored by the Billiard Digest and Chris's Billiards in Chicago and took place at Chris's. Several cue makers and a ball manufacturer also participated in the support of the tournament. The 32 player field was filled with players from around the country and world, including California, Florida, New York, Canada, Mexico and Sweden. After three days of top playing, the tournament ended up in a four way dead heat. During the fourth day and through the finals all four players scored an average of over 1 point per inning. FINAL RESULTS: FIRST PLACE - GEORGE ASHBY, Las Vegas, Nevada - SECOND PLACE - ALLEN GILBERT, Los Angeles, California - THIRD PLACE - FRANK TORRES, North Hollywood, California - FOURTH PLACE - TORBJORN BLOMDAHL of Helsingborg, Sweden.

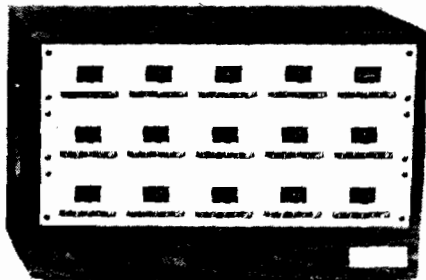

### PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

The 1983 National Championships — Classic III  
Players competing in this  
events will have been awarded entry along with their  
STATE or MAJOR TOURNAMENT TITLES. Others  
will qualify through the CLASSIC POINT format or in  
league competition. Still Others may elect to com-  
pete by payment of the open entry. The NATIONAL  
POOL CLASSIC is the exciting climax of each year's  
pool season that determines the new NATIONAL  
CHAMPIONS

These events are recorded in  
the NPCA Record Books.

NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIPS

High school students from around the country are being invited to compete in the National High School Championships which will be held during Classic III at the Mart Plaza Hotel in Chicago on December 1, 1983. The at large entry fee into this event is \$75.00. The field is limited in both the boys and girls divisions to 50 players. Only the Sanctioned State High School Champions and the first received paid entries will be eligible to compete. At this point in time the NPCA reports receiving about 10 open entries. The field of State Champions in this years event totals approximately 20 players. The NPCA is adding approximately \$1,000.00 to the 1983 Classic High School Scholarship Fund and another \$1,000.00 has been pledged by Advanced Satelite Systems of Elgin Illinois. With a full field in both divisions, this years prizes to the high school competitors could reach \$8,000.00

NATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS COULD BE BIGGEST EVER

THE NPCA has included a NATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP event with both a mens and womens division to this years CLASSIC. The open entry fee is \$120 per player on the five person teams. ONE HUNDRED percent of all entries will comprize the cash awards for the tournament. The NPCA has scheduled STATE TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS as qualifiers for the event. One half of all the entries at the qualifiers are also being added to the National Team prize fund.

PROFESSIONAL MEN AND WOMEN AT CLASSIC III

Thus far, the NPCA has awarded 17 STATE CHAMPIONSHIP OR MAJOR TITLE spots in the mens division and 10 in the womens division of Classic III. Another 20 events are scheduled to take place prior to the October 31 Season ending, reports Sue Link of the NPCA Tournament Staff. Estimates indicate that at least 24 men players and 12 women players will qualify through the Classic Point System. This years Classic will be limited to 128 Men Players and 64 Women players. Estimating 50 of the men will enter through the qualifying programs, the at large entry of \$350.00 will be open to approximately an additional 80 players. NPCA President, Harold Simonsen reports the NPCA will push to fill the field. These open entries could add almost \$30,000 in the mens division and estimating 35 open women entries, approximately \$10,000 to the womens division. Traditionally, the NPCA adds funds collected through memberships and sanction fees that are over and above operation costs. The NPCA has added over \$10,000.00 in each of the previous Classics.
